WHAT IS COPYRIGHT?;

Copyright is the right that the author of a work of the mind has over it, i.e. the right that enables him to control the use of his work.

WHAT ARE RELATED RIGHTS?

Related rights are rights that give protection to those persons (natural or legal) who contribute to the commercial production, interpretation, performance and distribution of works either by presenting them to the public or by investing financially in their exploitation and dissemination.
